#### **CARITAS AWARD**

This award will be judged by a representative from Caritas Australia. Artworks from either the Fra Angelico or General Categories may be nominated for this award.

#### **PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD**

The People's Choice Award is back for 2010. The public attending the exhibition will be given the opportunity to vote for their favourite artwork and the piece with the most votes will win the "People's Choice Award". The winner will be announced at the end of the exhibition.

**Art Work Submission** All art must be submitted to the Catholic Arts Office, 103 Wood Street, Inglewood between Monday, August 2 and Friday, August 6 2010. Office hours are strictly 8am to 4pm. A location map is attached. Labels A, B & C must be completed. Please follow instructions carefully.

**In fairness to all schools, no more than SIX (6) pieces of artwork per school can be submitted.**

**Copyright** Please make sure students' sign Label C (Registration form), which authorises the reproduction of artwork images in publications and the Catholic Arts/Catholic Education websites.

**Entry Fee** To assist with covering costs a fee of \$10 per entry will be charged. Invoices will be issued by the Catholic Arts Office. Please do not send money with artworks.

**Promoting Angelico** Posters advertising the Angelico Art Exhibition will be sent to all secondary schools. Principals and art teachers are asked to actively promote the Exhibition within their school community. Schools are encouraged to contact their local newspaper regarding students' participation.

**Opening Night** An official invitation will be forwarded to the Principal, Art Teacher, participating students and their parents/guardians.

For catering purposes, schools must advise number attending the Opening Night.

**"Award Presentations"**

**Students' receiving Awards at the Opening Night must be in full school uniform.**

**Setting Up/ Dismantling** The knowledge and expertise of art teachers' is invaluable in setting up and dismantling the exhibition. This occurs on the Saturday mornings prior to and immediately after the Exhibition. Please complete and return the 'Help Request Form' if you are able to assist in setting up/dismantling the Angelico Exhibition. Any assistance would be greatly appreciated.

**Visiting the Exhibition** Schools are encouraged to view the Exhibition at the Forrest Centre during business hours (8.30am – 5.00pm) from Monday August 16 to Friday August 27.

**Art Work** All artwork is to be collected between Monday August 30 and Friday September 3 from the Catholic Arts Office (office hours are strictly 8am to 4pm). Please note that removal of artwork from the exhibition venue will not be permitted without prior arrangement with the Catholic Arts Office.
