What do you think about... happening?

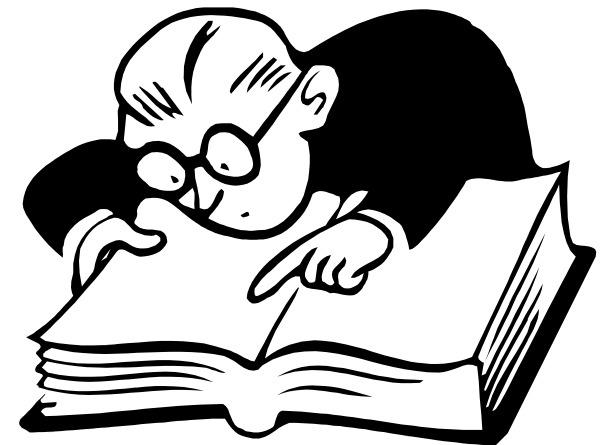
Describe what the character or setting looks like?

How would the story be different if it was from another point of view?

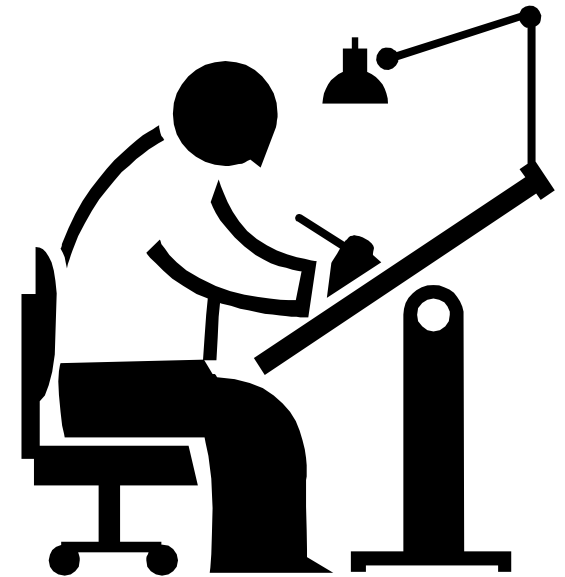


TEXT USER

Draw something about the story or how you feel about what has happened so far.

Draw a character, a place, a problem, a predication about the story or something the story reminds you of.

Draw something that the text reminds you of in your life or in the life of someone you know.



CODE BREAKER

Find tricky words and discuss how you worked out how to say them, what they meant...

Find interesting words and discuss them.

You could look for words that:

- **Are puzzling**
- **Help you see pictures in your head**
- **Remind you of someone you know**
- **Are tricky to pronounce**
- **Have unusual spelling**
- **Look at nouns, verbs and adjectives**
- **Have the same sound or letter pattern**
- **Find other words that mean the same**
