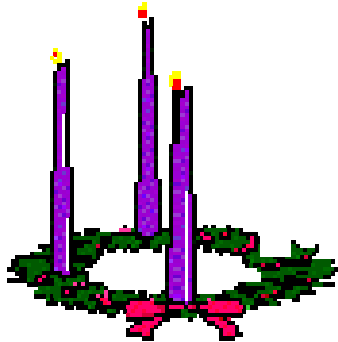


## VISION STATEMENT

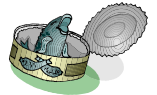
