

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE DATA 2008

The figures refer to the year 2008. The information is also available on our website:

Staff Attendance

Staff average just over one school day a year absent for sickness or other leave equating to an attendance rate of 99%.

Staff Retention

One part-time staff member left at the end of 2008.

Teacher Qualifications

Our teaching staff all possess a four year degree in education. In addition, there are four teaching staff with a Master's degree and one with a Doctorate in Education. There are also several staff members with second degrees and diplomas.

Professional Learning

All teachers have undertaken a variety of professional learning activities as detailed in School Board and P & F reports. The school spent an average of around \$1500 per teaching staff member on professional learning.

Student Attendance.

Student attendance in 2008 was over 96%.

Benchmark Results—variation 2007—2008.

87% of our WALNA results were above the benchmark in 2007. In 2008 94% of our results were above the benchmark.

Value Added

The school adds value to the school and curriculum by its investment in capital maintenance, professional development, physical (e.g. computers) and human (e.g. specialist support staff) curriculum resources.

Parent, student and teacher satisfaction.

Based on discussions at 3-way interviews, P & F meetings, School Board meetings, parent morning teas, class meetings, staff meetings, and information from evaluation and planning processes, it can be stated that most of the school community is reasonably to very satisfied with the school.
