General Information for 2010 Years 8 - 12

Department of Education Information on School Contributions and Charges:

Parent/Guardian

Section 12 of the Education Act gives Government Secondary Schools the authority to set and collect school charges within set guidelines. Copies of the relevant section of the Education Act can be obtained on request.

Lower School

The basic charge of \$235 provides textbooks, daily classroom consumables, homework diary and information technology facilities.

Students need to provide personal stationery requirements such as files, pens, paper, and calculators.

Elective Units

Elective units outside the basic core program **will incur additional charges above** the basic fee of \$235.

Charges for Elective Units are required to be paid at the start of the school year. Please refer to the Non Payment of School Contributions and Charges section below.

Senior School

50% of contributions and charges are required to be paid at the start of the school year.

Charges will depend upon the course chosen. Please refer to the Non Payment of School Contributions and Charges section below.

Some specific courses will incur high costs dependent upon such items as text, subject specific resources, materials, excursions, certificates and work placement. Students involved in **work placement must pay the associated contributions and charges prior to commencement** of the work placement.

Voluntary Charges

These are set for Amenities, Parents and Citizens Association and Chaplaincy. Please see section on optional charges.

Non-Payment Of Charges

School charges are due at the commencement of the school year. Secondary assistance, part payments, instalment agreements or periodic bank debits **must be organised with the Business Manager before the end of Term One.**

Non-commitment by the End of Term One

If charges are not paid or arrangements to pay have not been made with the Business Manager by the end of Term One:

- Students will be **unable to attend non-curricular activities** such as excursions, camps and organised school activities.
- Lower school students **may be moved from future elective units**, which are outside the basic core program, to other units.

Non-commitment by the End of April

If arrangements to pay money owing have not been made by the end of April, students **will be placed in basic core subjects for the following year** and debt collection procedures will be initiated.

While these arrangements will be instituted as a last resort, it is important that all parents pay school charges. It is not fair for parents who do not pay the charges to be subsidised by those who do pay.

Parents/Guardians are asked to pay the following optional Charges:

AMENITIES

An administrative charge of **\$10.00** per student is payable to the school. Funds derived from this levy are used to cover costs of diary, newsletters, brochures and programmes and to support expenditure on items such as photocopiers and audiovisual equipment.

CHAPLAINCY

A family charge of **\$7.00** to support the presence of a Support Service of a Non-denominational Chaplain who is an integral part of the school's Student Services team.

P&C

A **family** charge of **\$25.00** designed to be the major fund-raiser for 2010. This will enable the P&C to purchase much needed equipment for students' use and relieve the pressure of a few volunteers to raise funds. Throughout the years, the P&C have supported many educational activities both overseas and interstate trips such as Country Week, Canberra, Germany, Year 12 Presentation Night. Karratha Senior High School P&C don't conduct regular raffles, fetes or other activities, which require parents volunteering their time.

BUS EXCURSION

The Bus Excursion charge of **\$11.00** contributes towards the cost of using the School Bus. Bus Excursion Fees not paid at the beginning of the year will incur costs on a per student per excursion basis.

YEARBOOK

Students/parents have the option of purchasing a 2010 School Yearbook at a cost of **\$25.00**.

Other items which may be required:

SAFETY GLASSES

It is a **Safety Requirement** of the school that students must have a pair of **Approved Safety Glasses** for all Design and Technology classes.

All Year 8 students will participate in these classes throughout the year and will need Safety Glasses.

Years 9 – 12 will require glasses only if participating in these classes as an Elective.

These can be purchased at the KSHS Uniform Shop at a cost of **\$10.00**.

TECHNOLOGY & ENTERPRISE WORKBOOKS

Workbooks are required for each T & E subject.

All Year 8's will require four workbooks.
 Year's 9 to 12 will require a workbook for each Design and Technology subject.
 These can only be purchased through KSHS at a cost of **\$3.00** each.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

The wearing of school uniform is compulsory for all students. Uniforms are available from the Uniform Shop.

STATIONERY

Students are responsible for provision of personal stationery items. Eg: Paper, pens, rulers etc, Lever Arch File, Dividers, or a Plastic Expander File, A4 Sheet Protectors or Divider Notebooks. These may be purchased from local shopping centre suppliers at reasonable prices.

General Information for 2010 Years 8 to 10

Charges in WA Government Schools are set at a maximum of **\$235** per student for a nominal curriculum. Funds raised from school charges are expended on **text and equipment essential** for teaching and which are not supplied by the Government.

At Karratha Senior High School the basic charge of **\$235** covers a resource fee of **\$10** for Information Technology and the supply of a school diary. Please refer to Karratha Senior High School Charges Policy for payment requirements.

TEXTBOOKS

All textbooks are provided on a class set/hire basis.

A replacement cost will be charged if any textbooks are lost or badly damaged.

This allows us to keep the cost of school fees down to a minimum.

KSHS SCHOOL DIARY

A School Information Directory and Homework Diary will be provided to all students at the start of the school year, the cost of which is in the Amenities Charge. Parents are asked to encourage daily use. **Replacement Diaries are \$10.00.**

General Information for 2010 Senior School

The School offer a variety of courses in Years 11 and 12. Requirements for materials, equipment resources and textbooks vary widely. For some courses the school supplies all materials and resources in return for the payment of a hire or resource charge; in other subjects there is a reduced charge, but a requirement that students **purchase textbooks**.

Fees for students enrolling in SIDE subjects will be invoiced separately early 2010.

TEXTBOOKS

Parents and students are asked to pay particular attention to the respective costs of subjects chosen, as school fees are compulsory in Year 11 and 12.

For those students requiring purchase of textbooks, Wooldridges has been contracted to supply all textbooks and optional Stationery requirements.

Students will be required to post or order online (through Wooldridge's Website) their booklists, including payment by cheque, credit card or money order to Wooldridges. An order form has already been issued to all students.
